15th to 20th JULY 2008 –ARENA UK, ALLINGTON, GRANTHAM, LINCS. NG32 2EF

CLASSES:

GROUP A: For riders who are under the age of 12 as at 1st January 2008
GROUP B: For riders who are under the age of 15 as at 1st January 2008
GROUP C: For riders who are under the age of 17 as at 1st January 2008
OPEN: For riders who are any age
VETERANS: For riders who are 25 years of age or over on 1st January 2008
(NB: The same pony may not be used if entering both Groups A & B or Open and Veterans Group as these classes are run concurrently)

ENTRIES:

Entries are restricted as follows:
Group A – 24, Group B – 48, Group C – 72, Open Group – 72, Veterans Group – 16. NB The Veterans group will only be run if sufficient entries are received. Entries will be accepted on a **first come, first served** basis. **PLACES CANNOT BE RESERVED BY TELEPHONE OR EMAIL.** No entry will be accepted without an accompanying cheque for the **FULL ENTRY FEE.** Post-dated cheques **CANNOT** be accepted. Places **CANNOT** be reserved without full payment. Entries will be acknowledged when they are accepted. Full competition details, including games, timings, etc. will be issued to all riders nearer to the date of the competition. All competitors must be members of MGA(GB) Ltd. or members of their national MGA. Closing dates for entries is **FRIDAY 4th July 2008.**

ENTRY FEES:

The entry fee for Groups A, B, C and Open is **£50** per CLASS, including corraling, all entry fees and camping, but **EXCLUDING** stabling. If a competitor wishes to enter more than one group, the entry fee for second and subsequent classes is discounted to **£45.** The entry fee for the Veterans Group is **£45.** Overseas riders will be required to pay **£5** in addition to the entry fee to cover temporary membership of MGA (GB) Ltd (for insurance purposes). **If you wish to book stables please add £15.00 + VAT (£17.63) per night to your entry fee.**

A place may be reserved by submitting an entry form, together with the full entry fee. The closing date for entries is **FRIDAY 4th July 2008.** There will be no cancellation refunds after Friday 4th July 2008 unless a Veterinary Certificate or Doctor's letter is produced. All cancellation refunds incur a **£5** administration fee.

GAMES & RULES:

All games and rules will be found in the International Mounted Games Association Rule Book.

RIDERS WILL BE DEEMED TO HAVE ACCEPTED THE RULES BY ENTERING THE COMPETITION.

LIABILITY:

Neither the Organisers, nor any person acting on their behalf, accepts any liability for any loss, damage, accident, illness or injury to ponies, horses or any other person or property whatsoever.

INSURANCE:

All members of MGA (GB) Ltd. are covered by the Association's Third Party Public Liability Policy. It is up to each rider to insure him/herself and their pony or property.

COMPETITION DETAILS

A full list of competition details, including games, timings etc. will be sent to all competitors in advance of the competition.

REFUSAL

The organisers reserve the right to refuse entry into the competition or refuse admittance to the Showground. No reason will be given for so doing.
